*Psalm 25:14 The secret of the Lord is with them that fear him; And he will shew them his covenant.*

### 3. Abraham's \_\_\_\_\_ (19:29)

LOT'S SPIRITUAL \_\_\_\_\_ (CHAPTER 19)

No Difference —accepted as 'one of them' and sitting at the gate (1)

No Separation— he called them *brethren* (7)

No Moral Strength—he offered out his daughters (8)

No Godward Influence—his son-in-laws mocked him (14)

No Spiritual Motivation—he lingered in the city (16)
